

Both directions of US 377 will face a total temporary closure between Benbrook and Cresson tomorrow, Wednesday, July 22, 2026, from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

The primary alternate route to bypass the closure is going north from Granbury to Weatherford via FM 51 North, and then taking Interstate 20 East straight into Fort Worth. This detour completely avoids the US 377 corridor bottleneck at Whiskey Flats adding roughly 15 to 20 minutes to the normal commute.

The daytime traffic halt on US 377 is primarily driven by critical utility relocations and advanced bridge infrastructure adjustments required to widen the highway corridor. Because the stretch through Whiskey Flats is a tightly constrained, two-lane bottleneck with no immediate shoulder clearance, TxDOT must completely halt traffic to safely maneuver heavy cranes and overhead utility rigging across the active lanes.
